Bindagraphics Lands Sesame Street Project

We recently completed a project for Sesame Workshop, the makers of Sesame Street. This special DVD kit (called "Talk, Listen, Connect: Helping families cope with Military Deployment") is designed to teach young military children and their caregivers how to deal with a parent's absence as a result of deployment.

The kit is a film-laminated, diecut DVD box folder that required folding, gluing the front super-panel, and converting the ¼ " capacity boxes. The converted pieces were then packed in cartons and shipped to numerous destinations. Total quantity for this job was 404,000 and was done on 18-point coated one-sided stock.

Thanks to our triple shift, round-the-clock operation, duplicity of equipment, and an impressive staff of dedicated, cross-trained operators, Bindagraphics' was able to produce 40,000 of these capacity folders daily.

Another Postal Increase??

Be advised that the U.S. Postal Service has filed for yet another postage increase with the Postal Rate Commission. If passed, first-class postage would increase by 7.1%, standard postage by 9%, periodicals by 11.7%, and package services (including parcel post, bounded printed matter, library mail, and media mail) by 13.4%.
